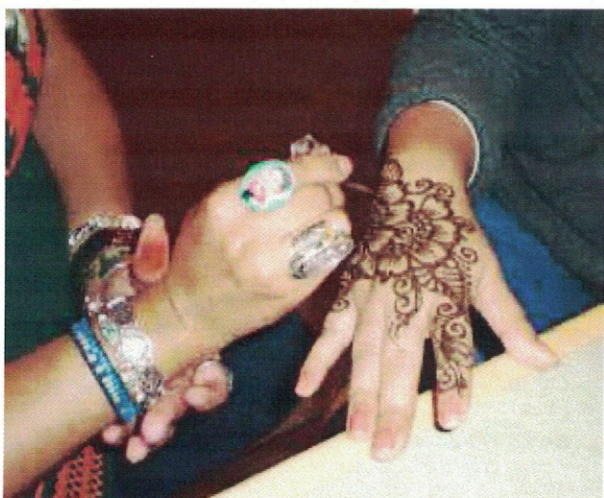




A Teen Summer Challenge Event

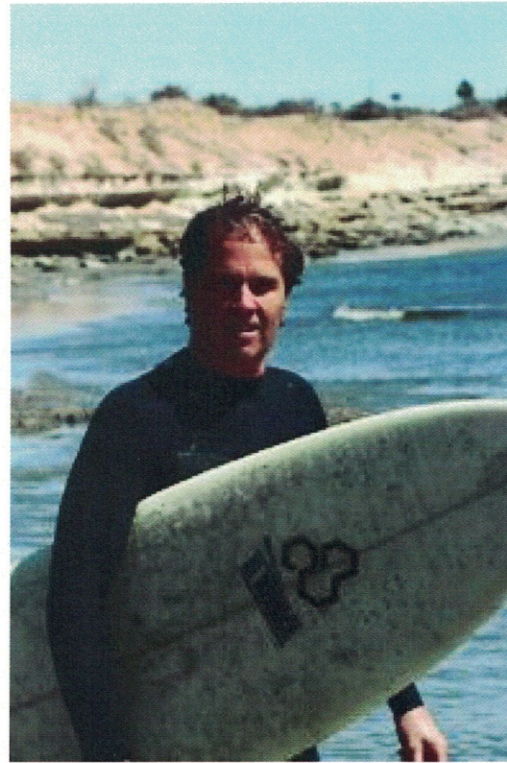
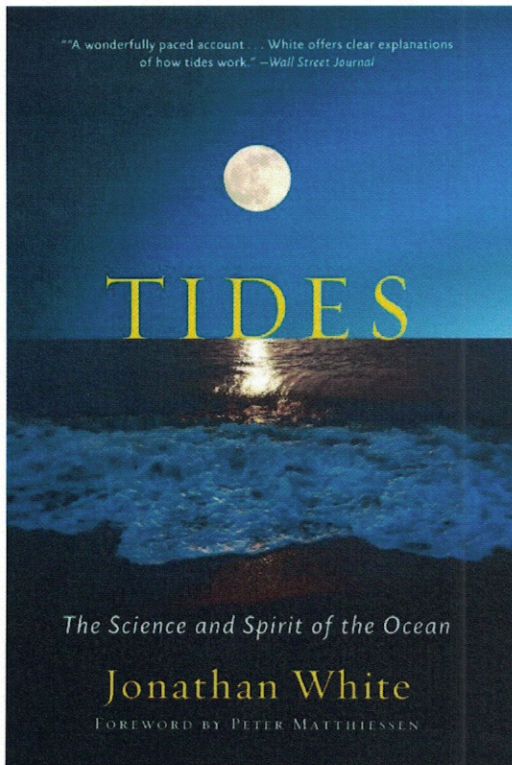

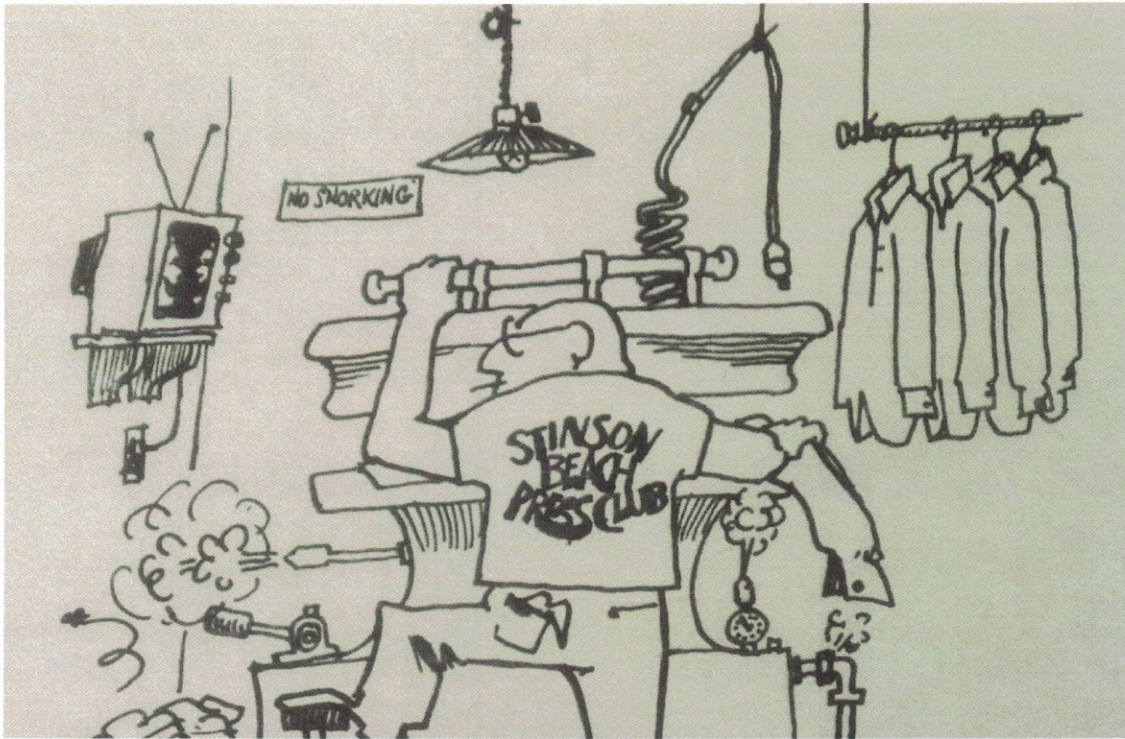
